ULACIT —Latin American University of Science and Technology, is a bilingual university located in San José, Costa Rica. For nearly 24 years, ULACIT has been providing culturally immersive, academic experiences to students from around the world in Costa Rica.

We offer 53 undergraduate and 42 graduate programs in the Schools of Business Administration, Engineering, Information and Communication Technologies, Film and Animation, Art and Design, Health Sciences, and Social Sciences. ULACIT attracts international students and faculty. As many as 9% of our students are international of 26 different nationalities. Our offering of courses taught in the English language is ample: 69 taught regularly at our San José and Escazú campuses in the fields of Liberal Arts, Business, Political Science, and International Relations.

All our teaching strategies are project-based, with no traditional exams. Learning is founded on inquiry, research, problem-solving and service learning experiences, under the Teaching for Understanding (TfU) framework, developed by Harvard University's Project Zero.
