Studying abroad will give you the opportunity to communicate with new professors, students, and friends. # How does it work?

Based on your interests and language skills, you will choose from more than 60 partner universities around the world. You can take classes for a semester or a year, and then transfer the credits to ULACIT. These programs are offered on a rolling basis in January and September of each year.

An internship experience abroad is the best way to put into practice your knowledge and abilities in an intercultural context. You'll also develop important technical and interpersonal skills, allowing you better opportunities in the job market.

# How does it work?

By pursuing an international internship, you can fulfill the 180-hour professional practice required by ULACIT. Depending on your professional interests and your language skills, you can choose from experiences in countries such as Colombia, Mexico, Brazil, Nicaragua, Italy, Germany, Poland, and Hungary, among others. These opportunities are offered at different times during the year.

By studying English in Chester, England, you will meet a diverse range of people and have the opportunity to build relationships with your multinational classmates. # How does it work?

Travel to Chester, England (40 minutes from Liverpool), where you'll take 21 hours of classes a week for a full month at a British Council-accredited institute. Get even more English practice during your free time, as you will be staying with a host family eager to help you improve your language skills.

English in Chester is also available to ULACIT students' relatives, so it is a great opportunity for your family members to improve their English and, therefore, their employment prospects.

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# Dual Bachelor's Degree Fairleigh Dickinson University New Jersey or Vancouver Campus

# How does it work?



Students must finish their program at ULACIT to obtain the second degree from FDU. The school year runs from August to May every year.

- Successful completion of all degree required courses
- Have achieved a grade average of 80 or above
- · Have a valid passport
- Have a minimum of 79 points on TOEFL IBT test
- Apply at least two quarters (eight months) before starting date

# Foro Europeo

The Foro Europeo Business School of Navarra was founded in 1992. Since then, more than 15,000 students from different countries at both the graduate and undergraduate levels have graduated with degrees authorized by the Government of Navarra.

With the dual degree program, you'll earn two MBAs, one from ULACIT and another from Foro Europeo with an emphasis in Strategic Leadership in Global Environments.

# How does it work?

Finish your MBA with ULACIT, or have at least 30% of credits completed; complete a-100-hour online program with Foro Europeo. Then travel to Navarra, Spain, where you will attend in-person classes for a week to complete the program. Students must finish their program at ULACIT to obtain the second degree from Foro Europeo. This program runs from April to June each year and from October to December.
